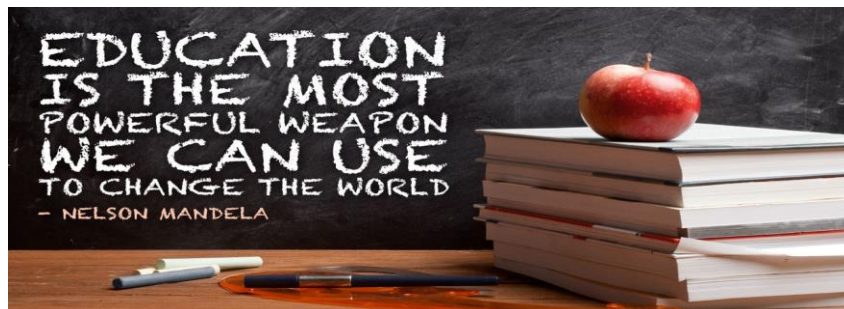
Education is the premise of progress, in every society and in every family. It remains one of the most powerful tools to reduce poverty, improve health, gender equality, peace and stability.

1. An estimate of 75 million children aged 3 to 18 live in countries facing war and violence, and need educational support.
2. Nearly 800 million people do not have basic ability to read or write.
3. There are more than 124 million primary or secondary school-aged children who are not in school around the world.
4. Ten million boys and 15 million girls will never receive a primary education.
5. If all students in low- income countries gained basic reading skills, 171 million people could be lifted out of poverty.
